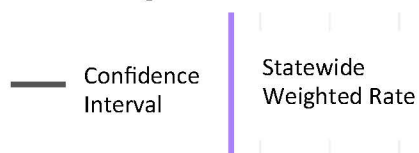

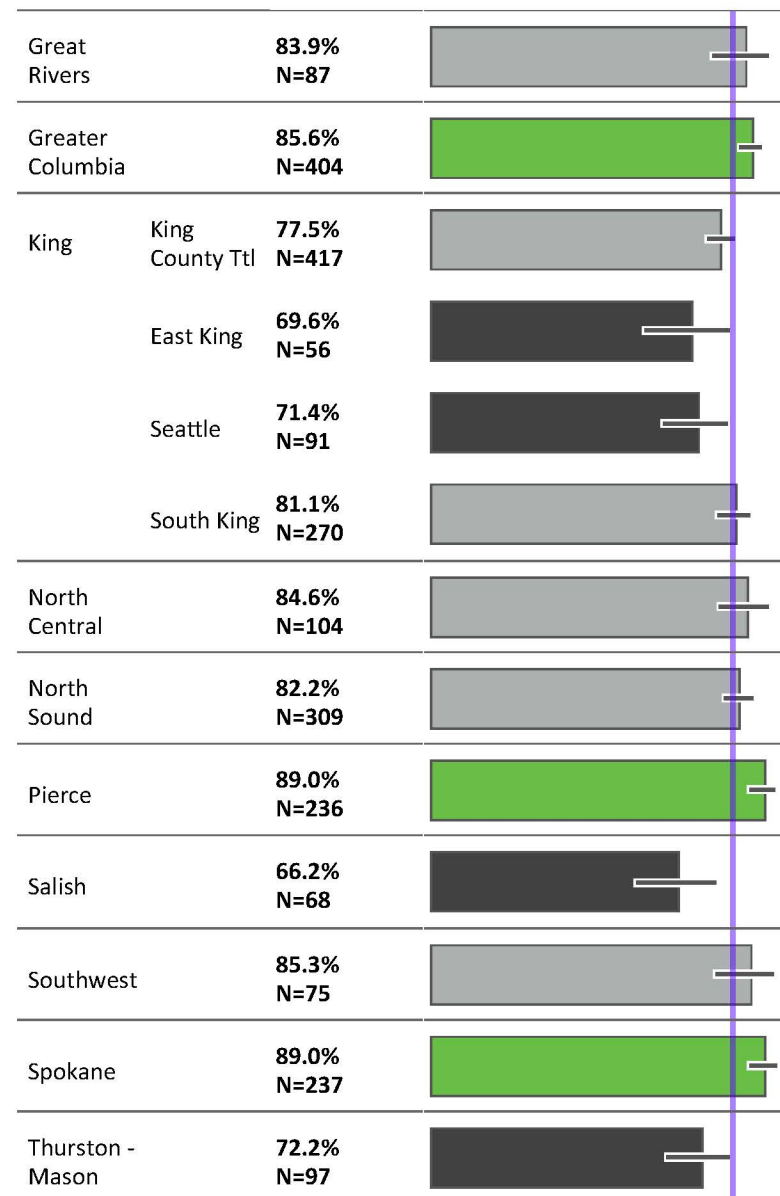

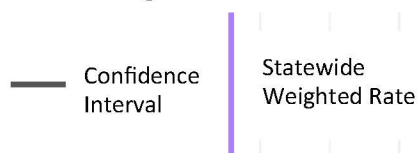

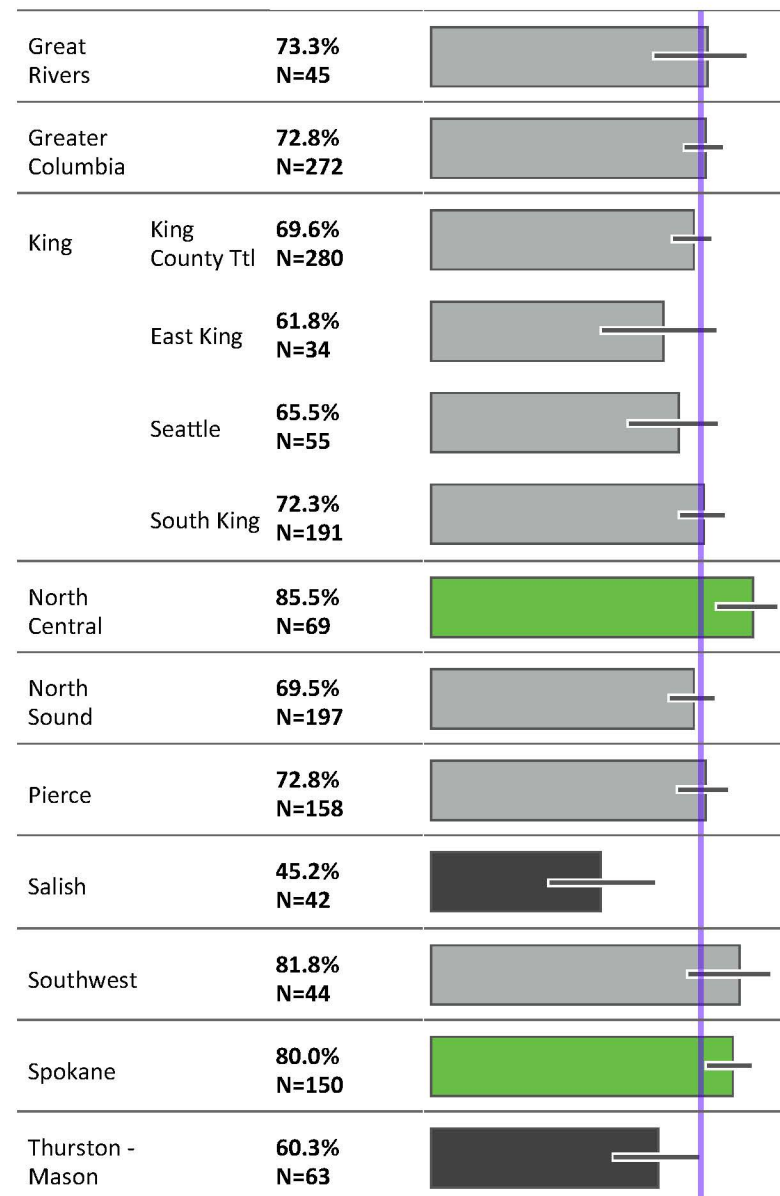

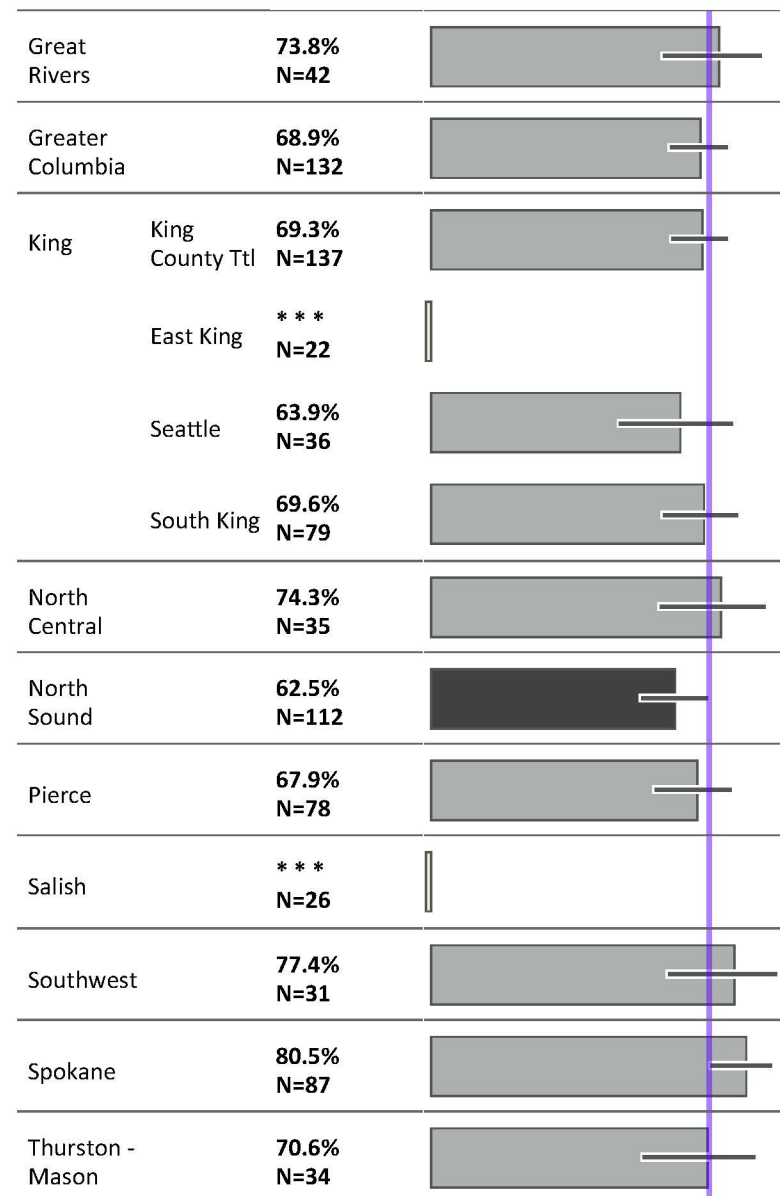

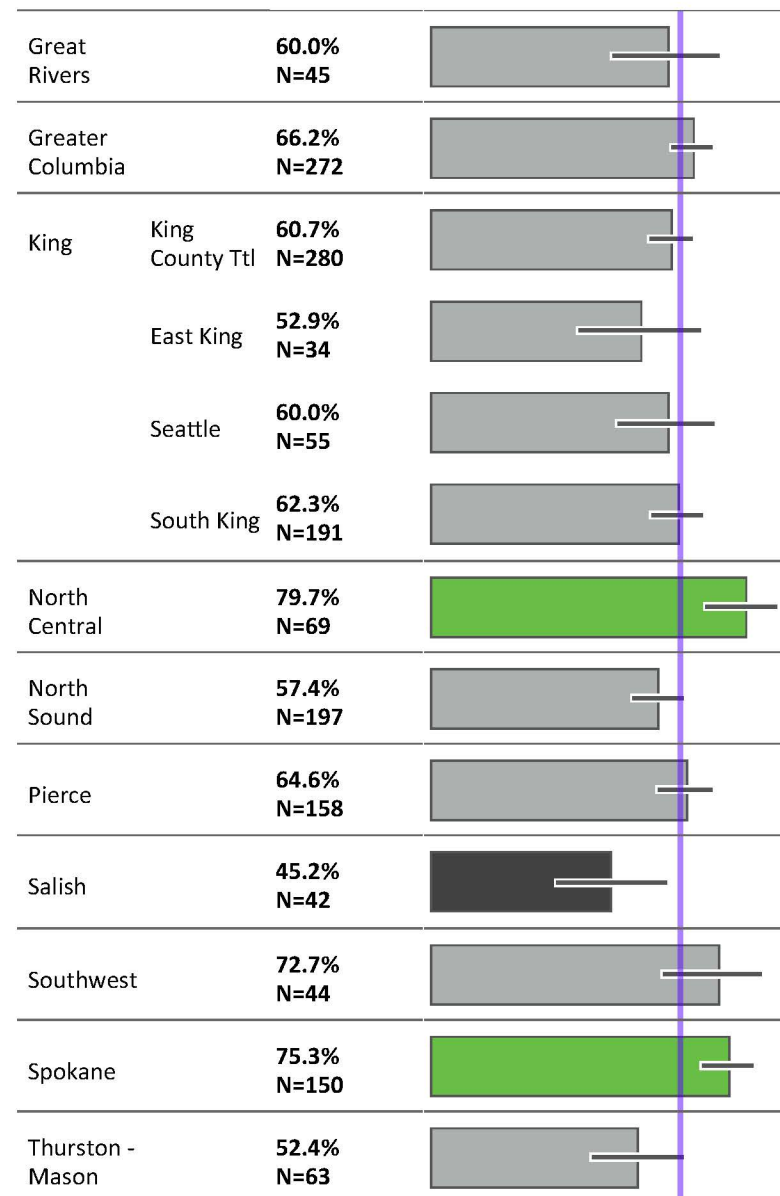

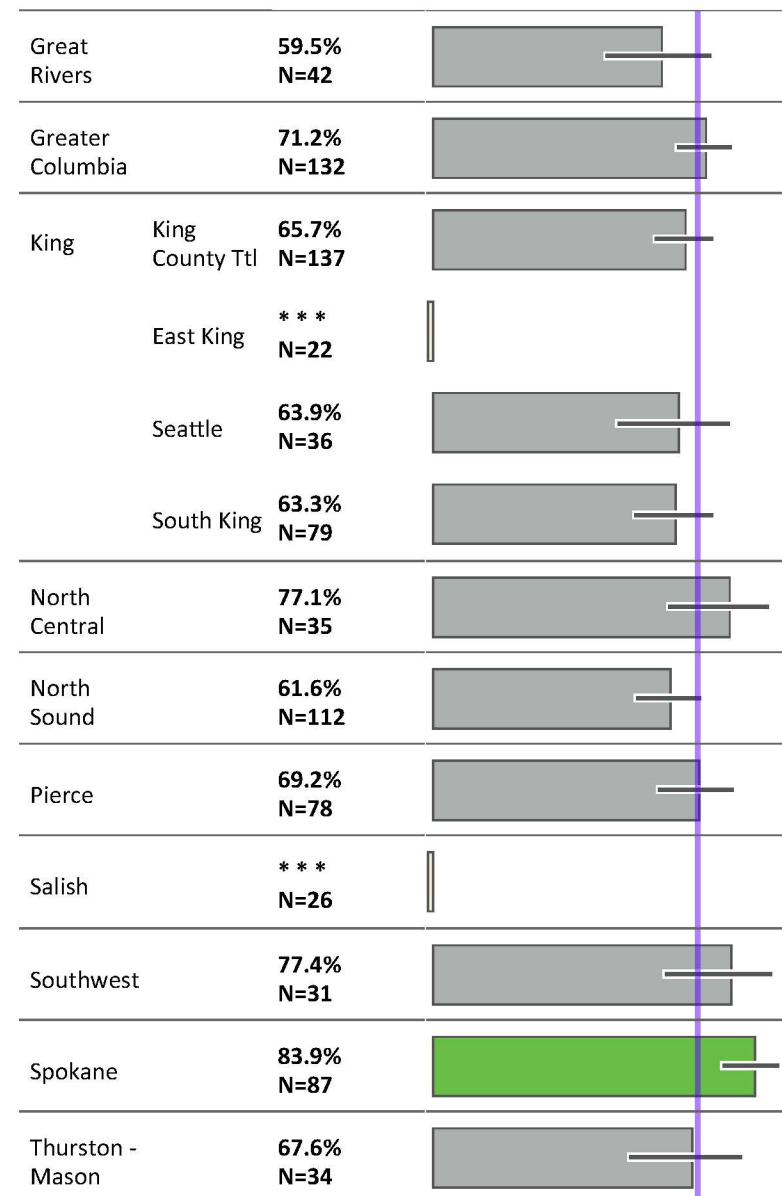

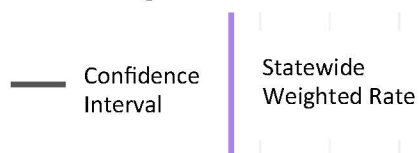

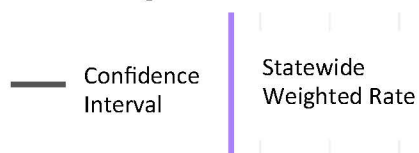

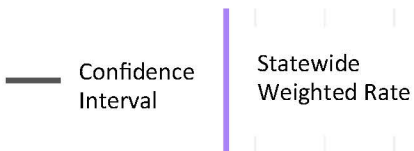

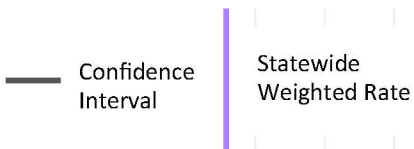

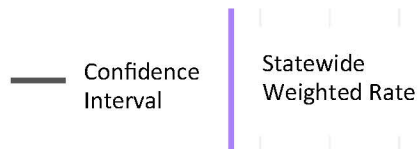

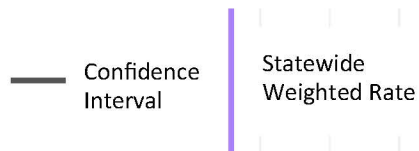

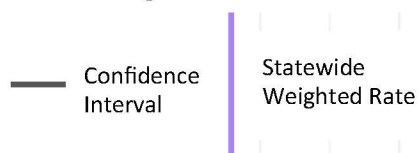

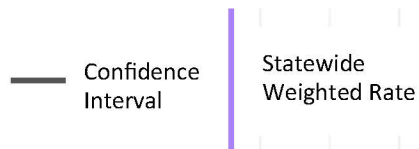

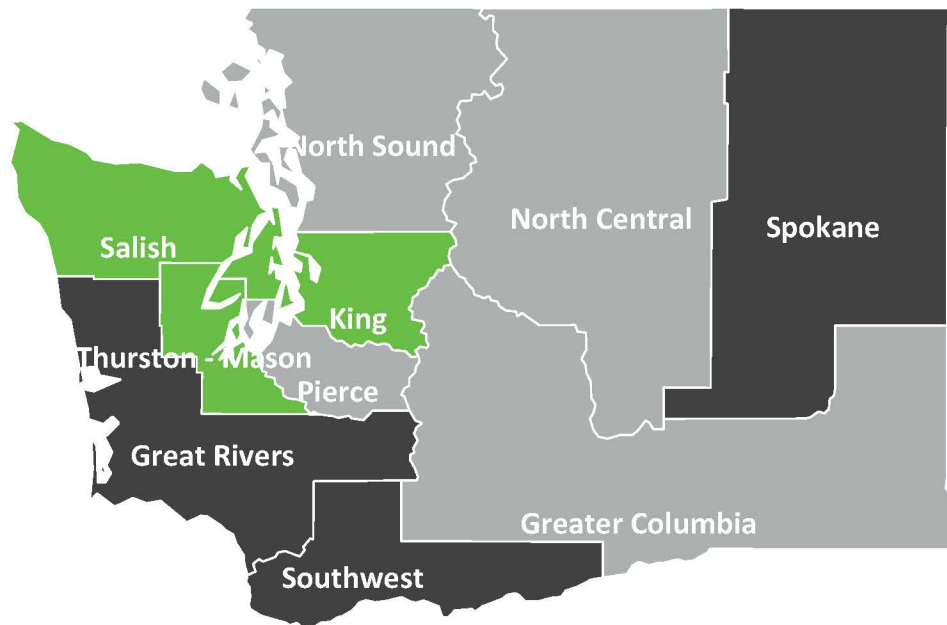

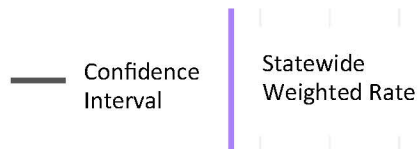

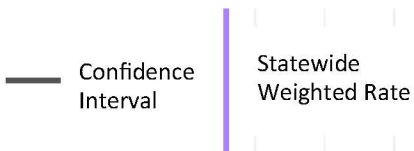

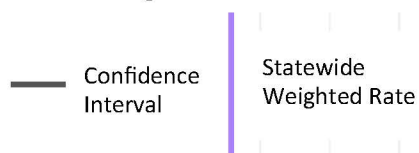

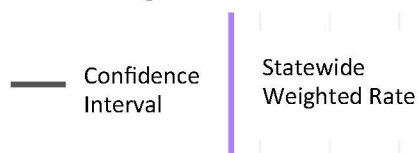

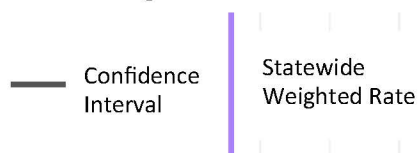

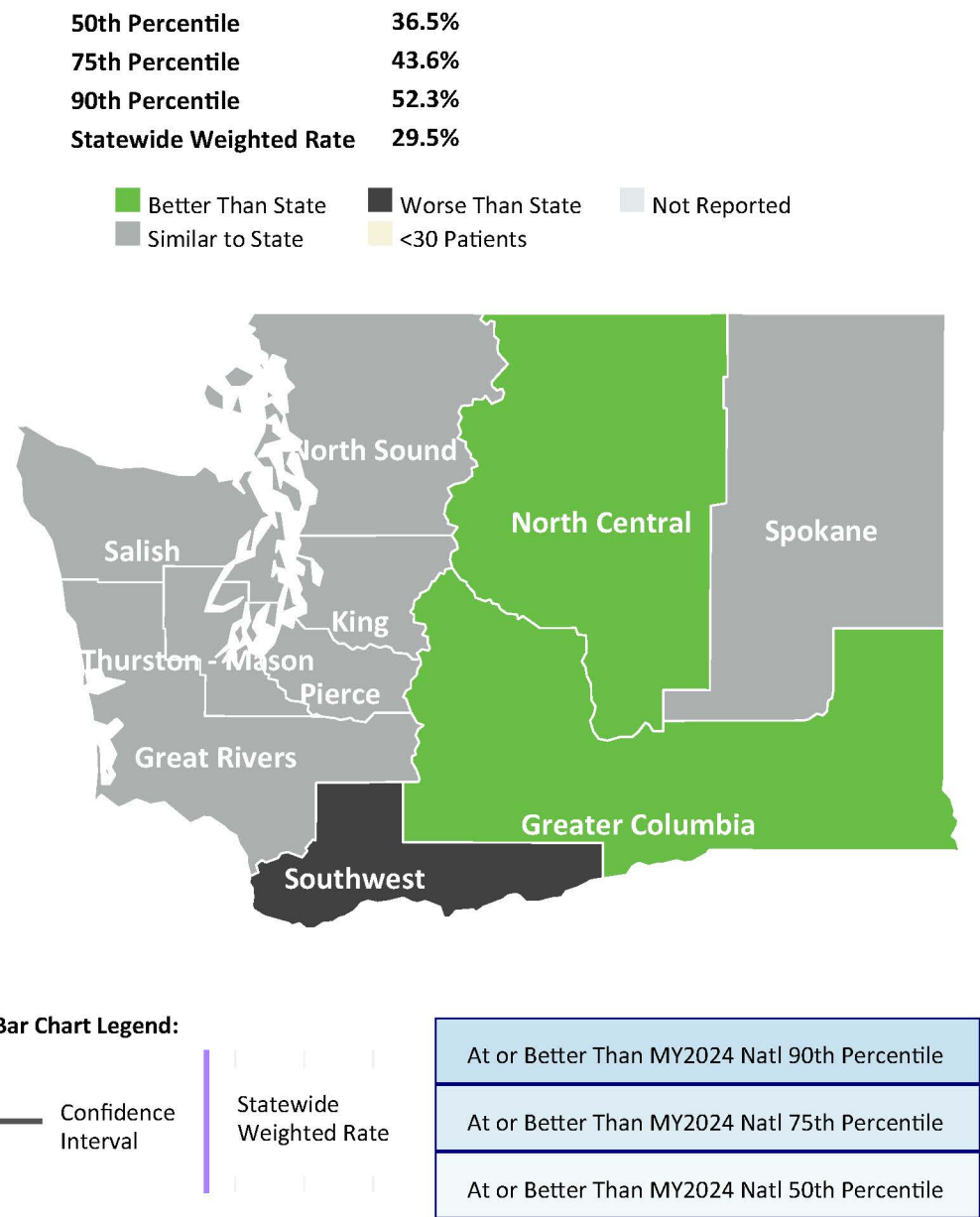

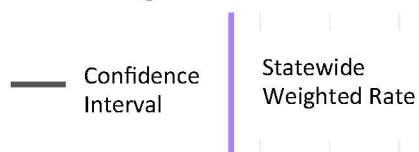

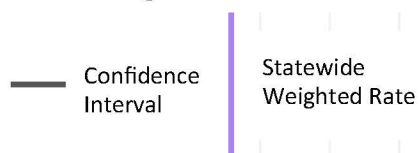

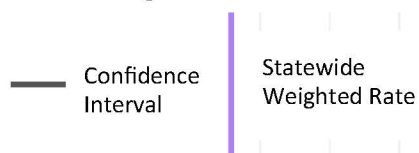

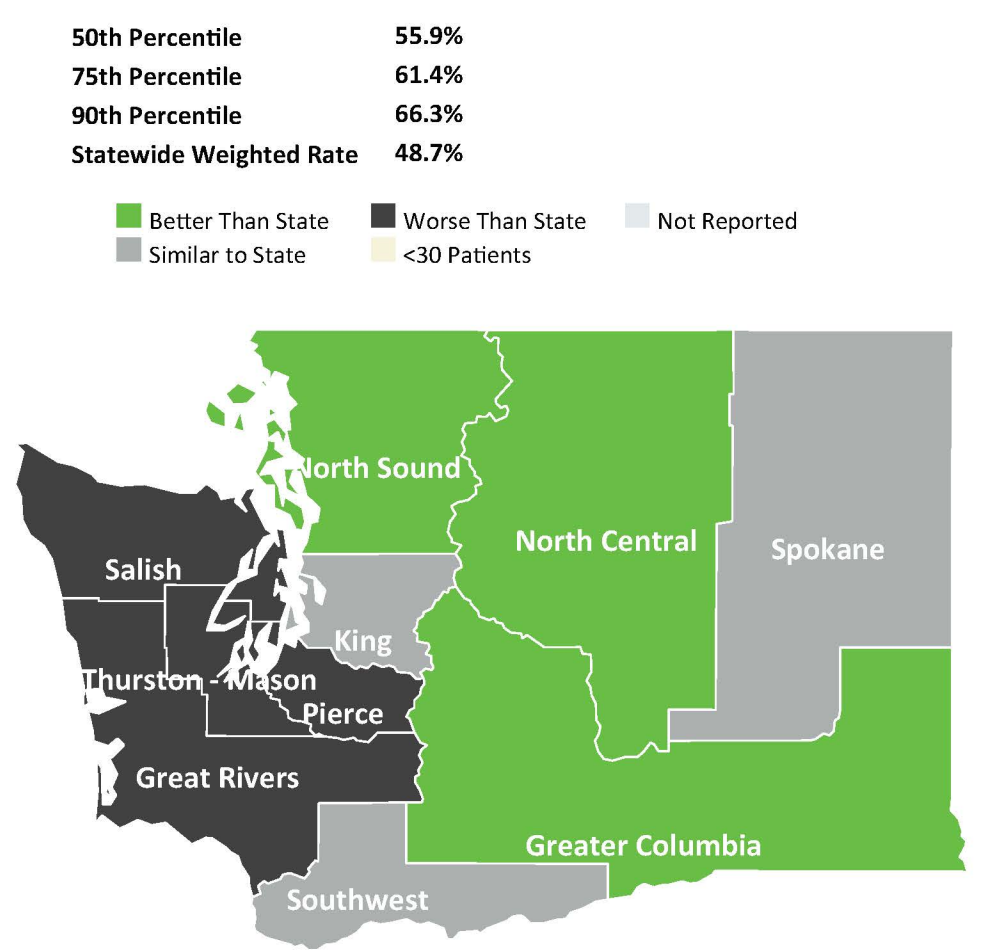

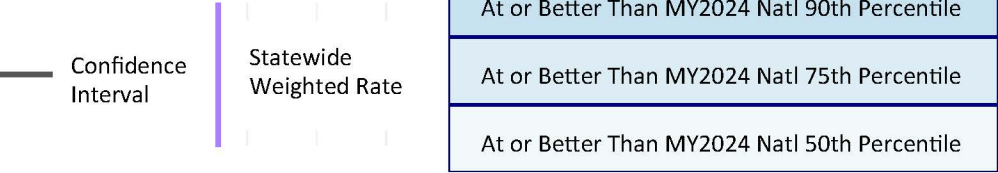

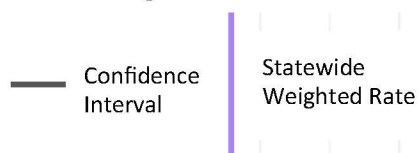

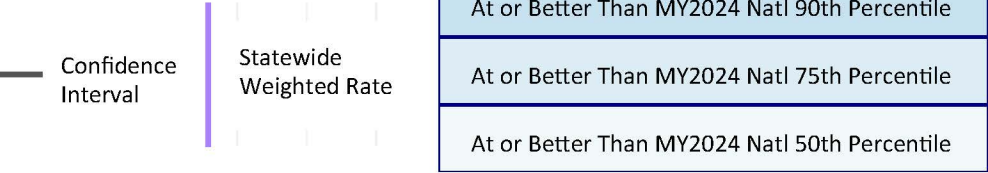

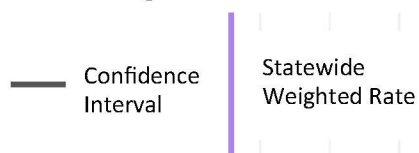

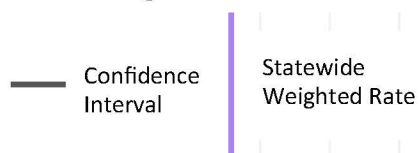

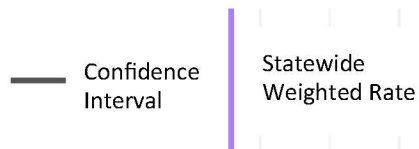

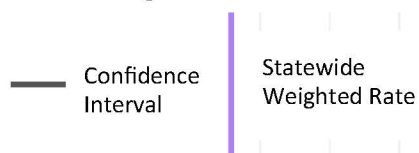

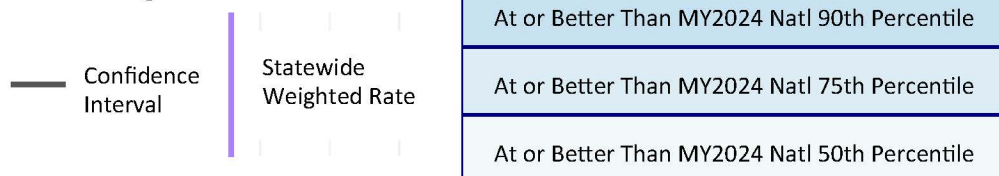
Asthma Medication Ratio (AMR), 12-18 Years

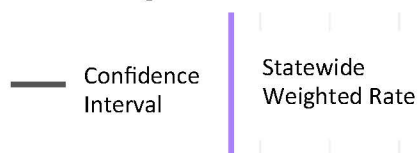

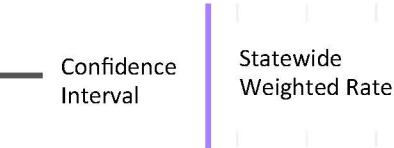

Statin Therapy for Patients With Cardiovascular Disease (SPC), Received Statin Therapy, 21-75 Years (Male)



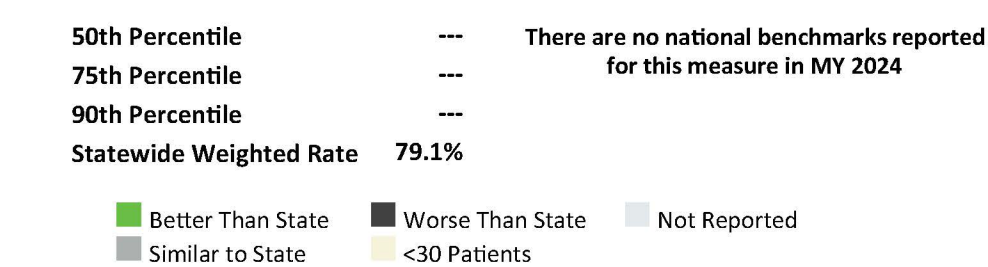

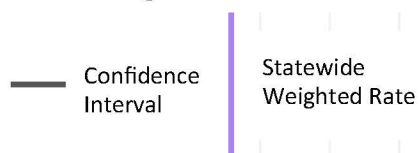

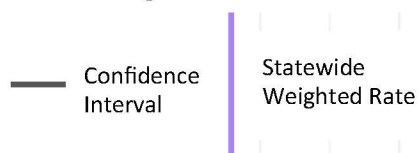

Cardiac Rehabilitation (CRE), Engagement1, Total



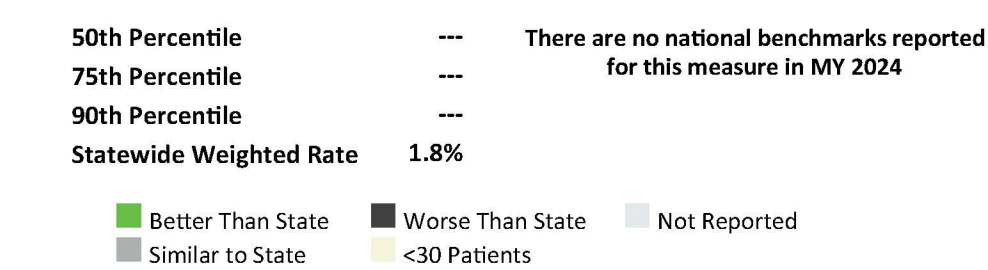

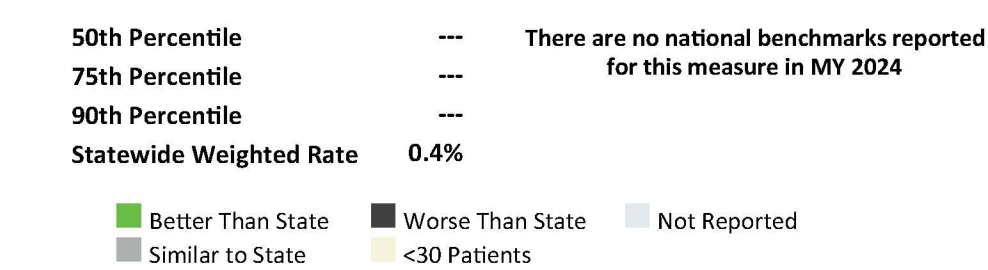

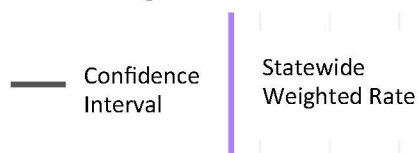

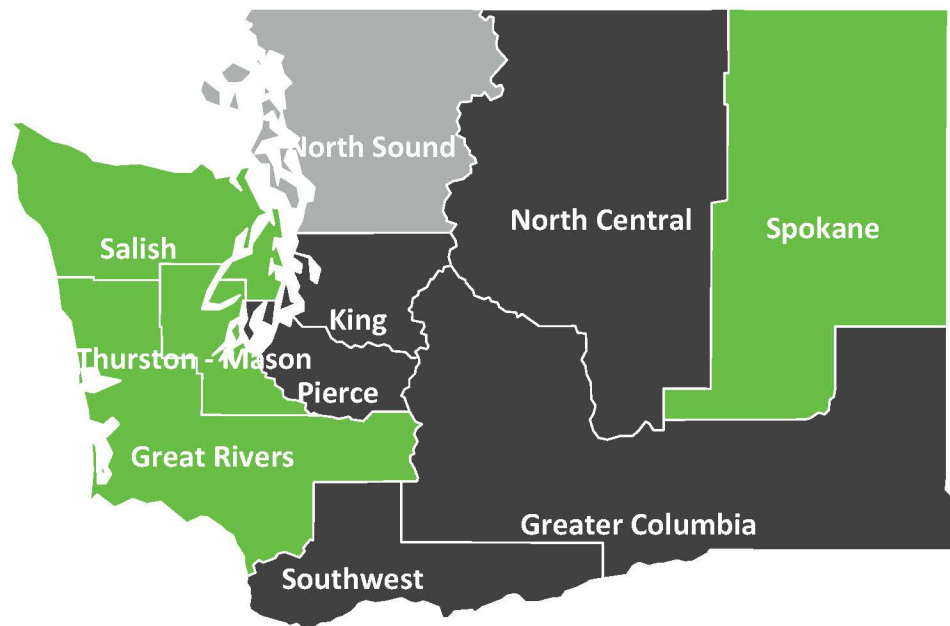

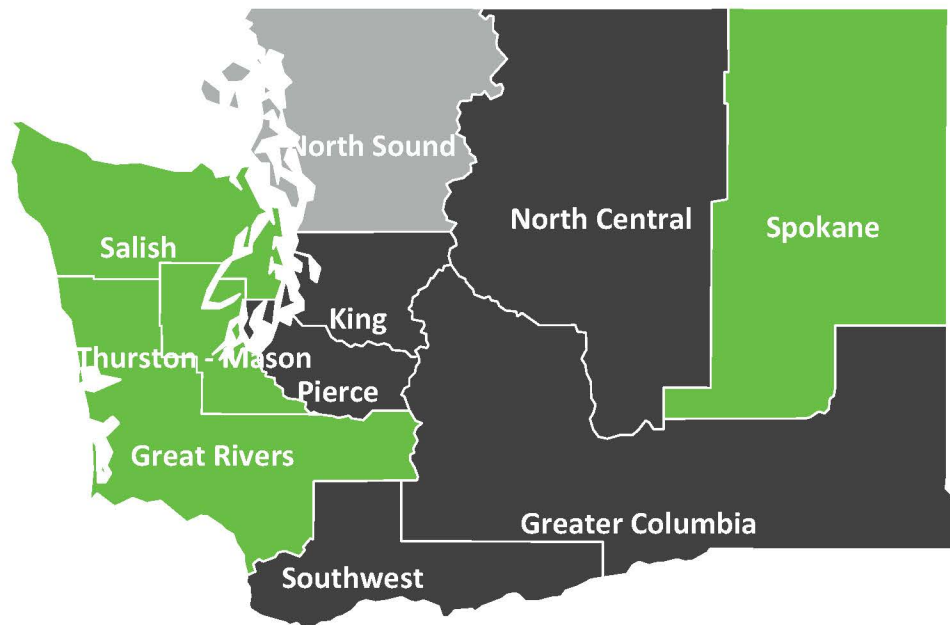

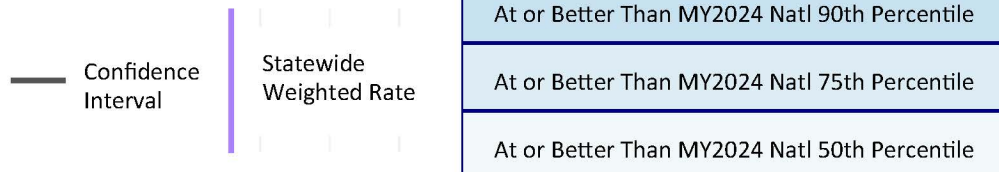

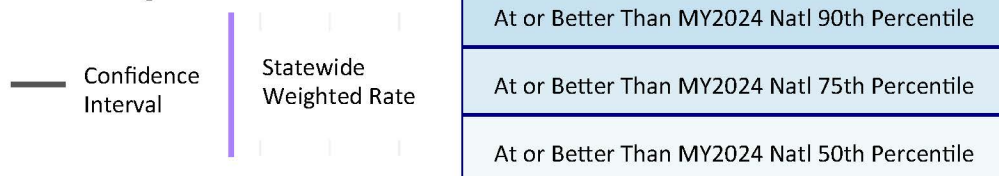

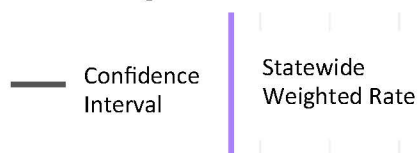

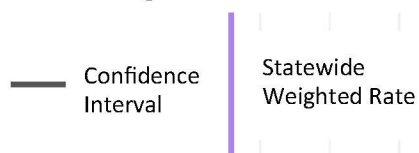

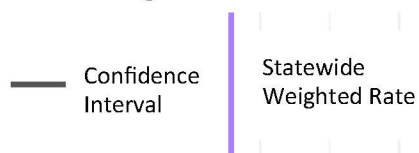

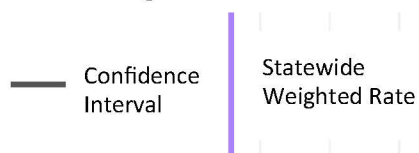

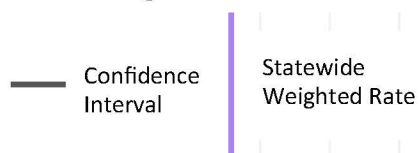

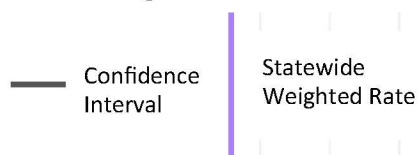

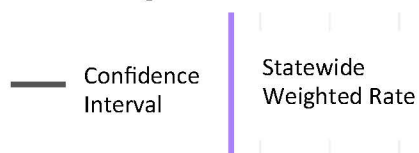

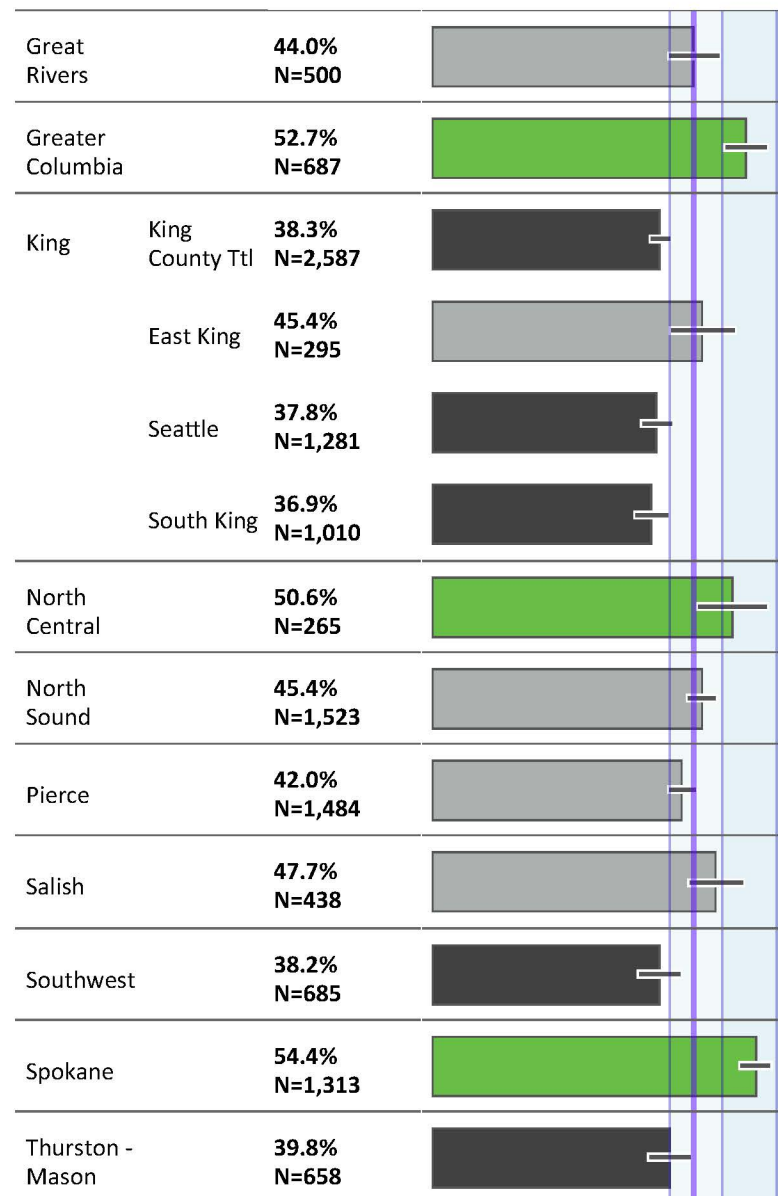

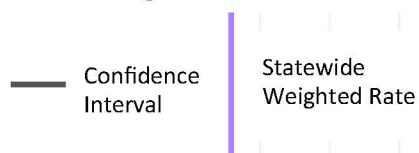

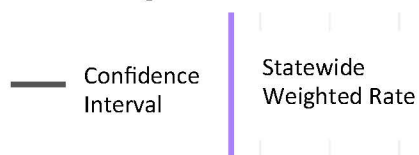

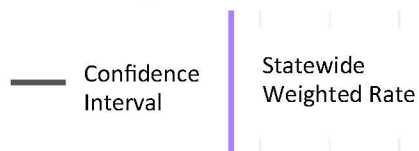

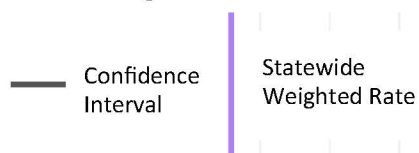

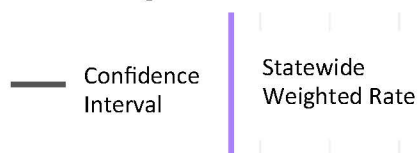

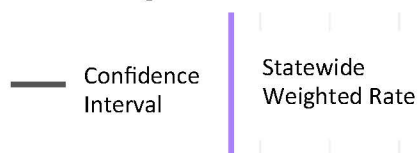

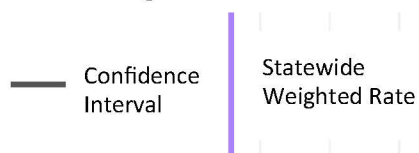

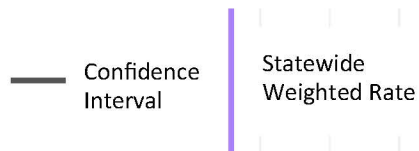

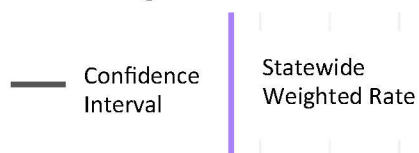

Pharmacotherapy for Opioid Use Disorder (POD), 16-64 Years



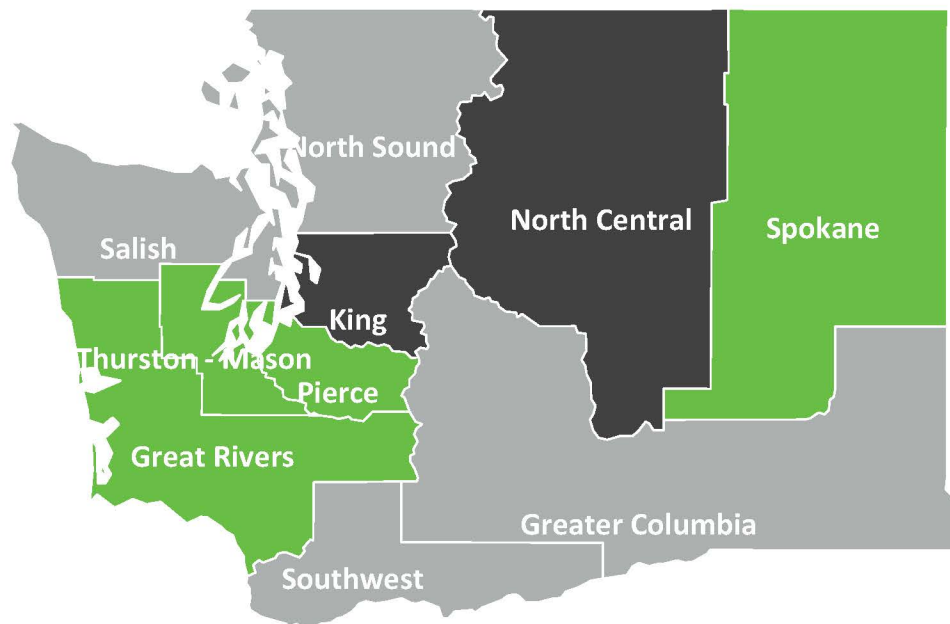

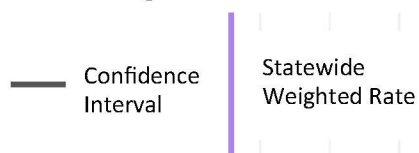

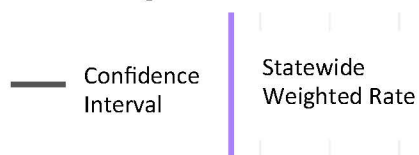

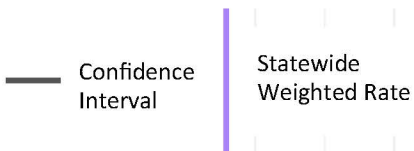

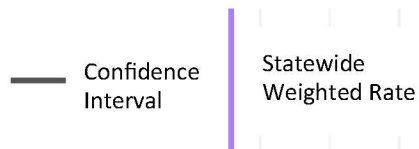

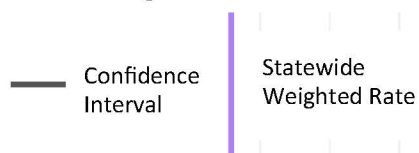

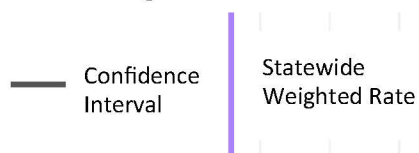

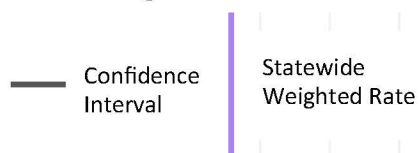

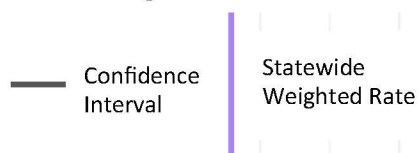

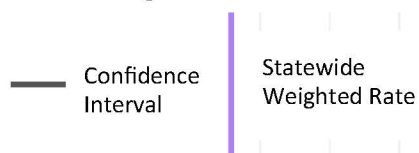

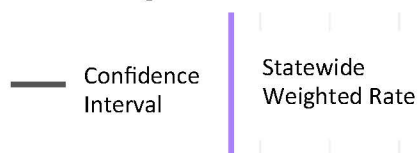

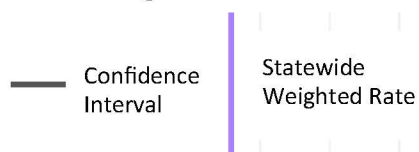

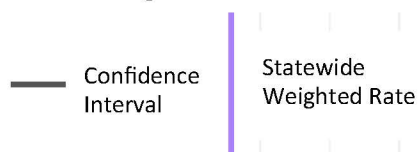

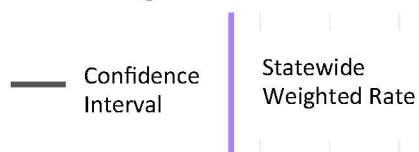

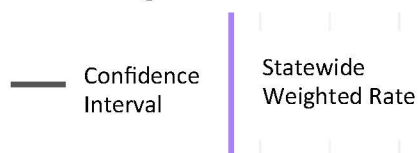

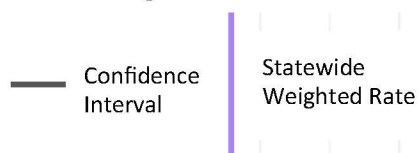

Avoidance of Antibiotic Treatment for Acute Bronchitis/Bronchiolitis (AAB), Total

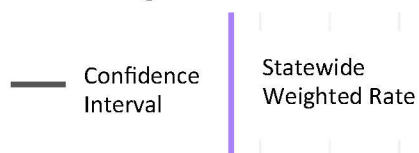

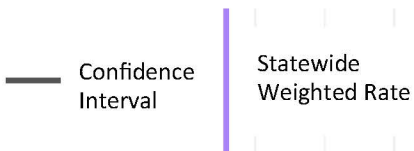

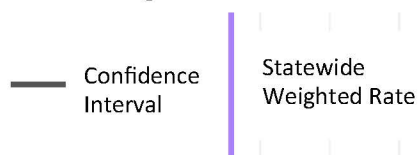

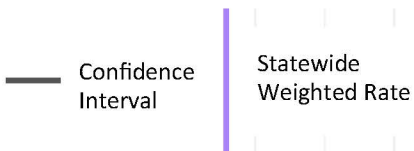

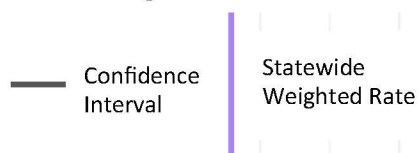

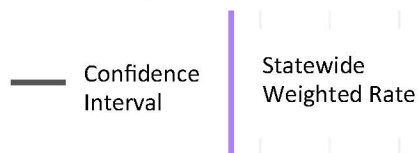

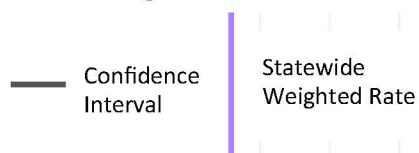

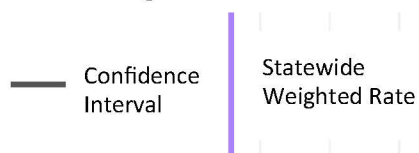

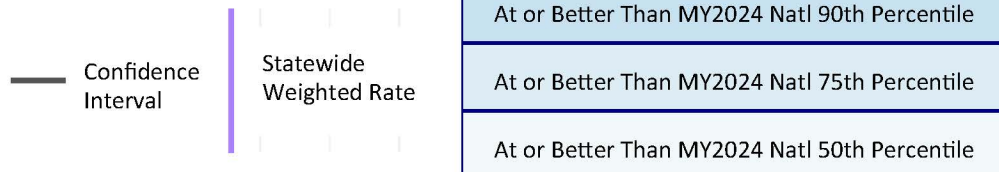

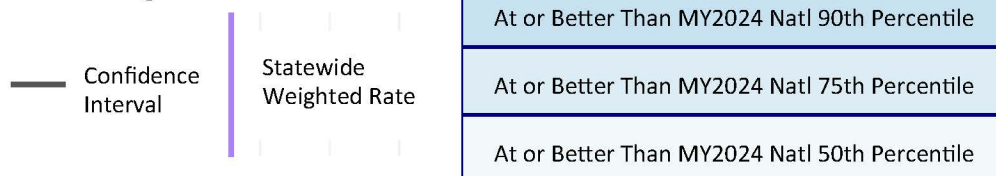

Well-Child Visits in the First 30 Months of Life (W30), 15-30 Months

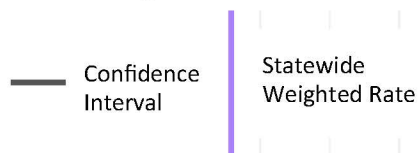

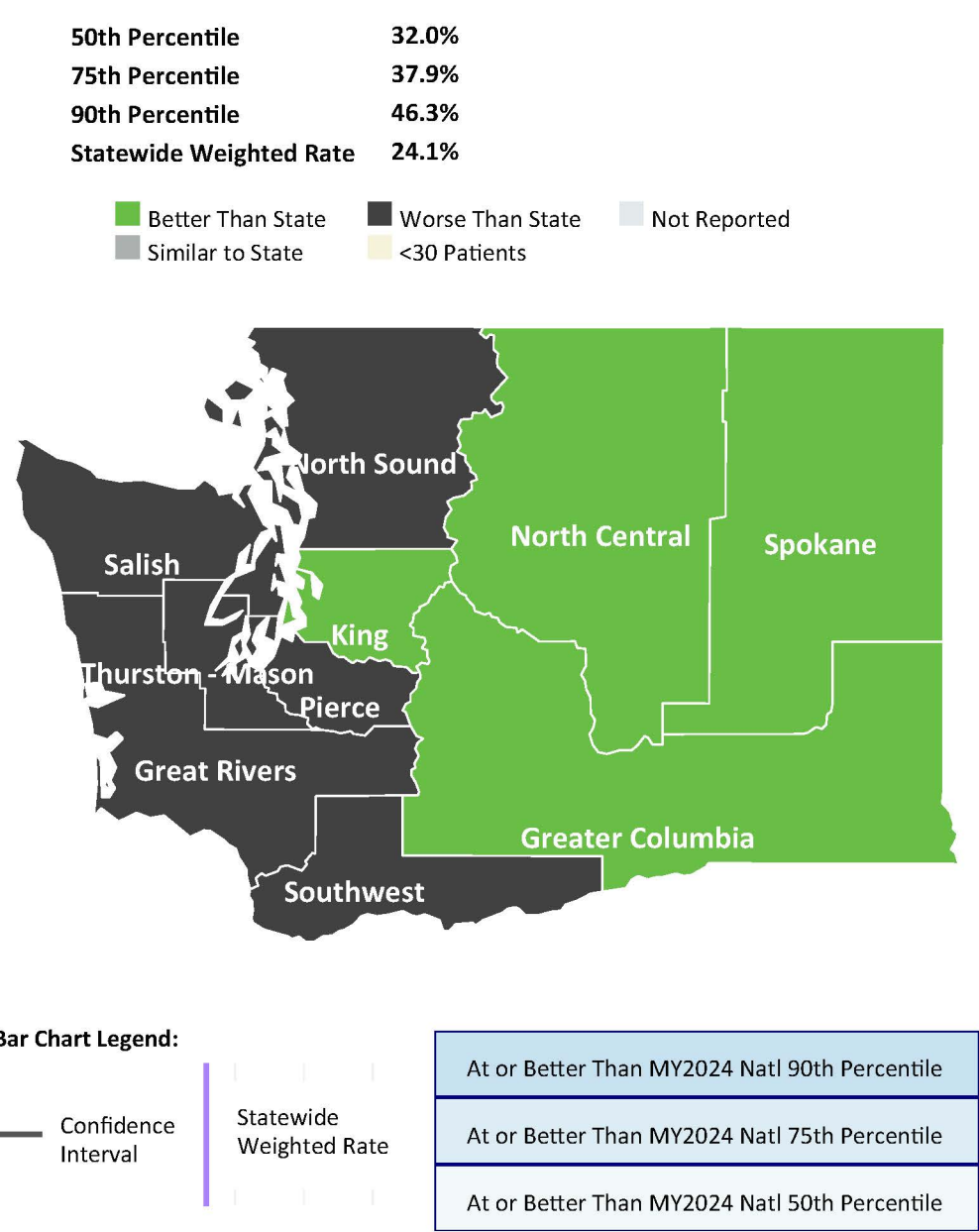

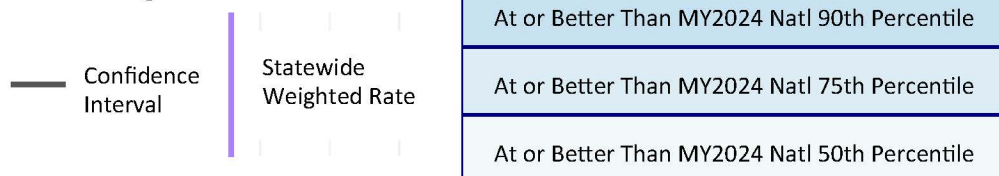

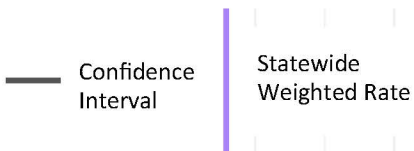

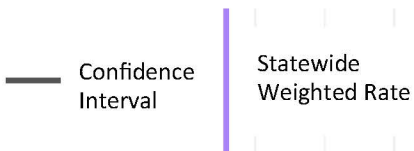

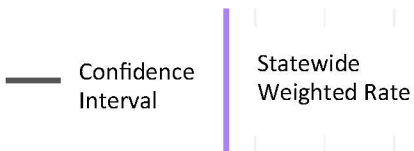

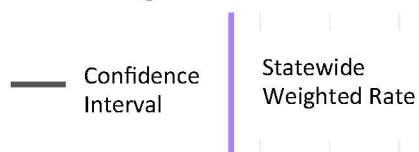

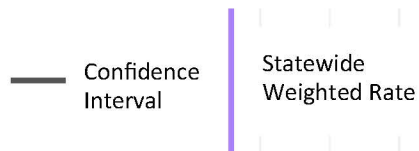

Depression Remission or Response for Adolescents and Adults (DRR-E), Follow-Up on PHQ-9, Total

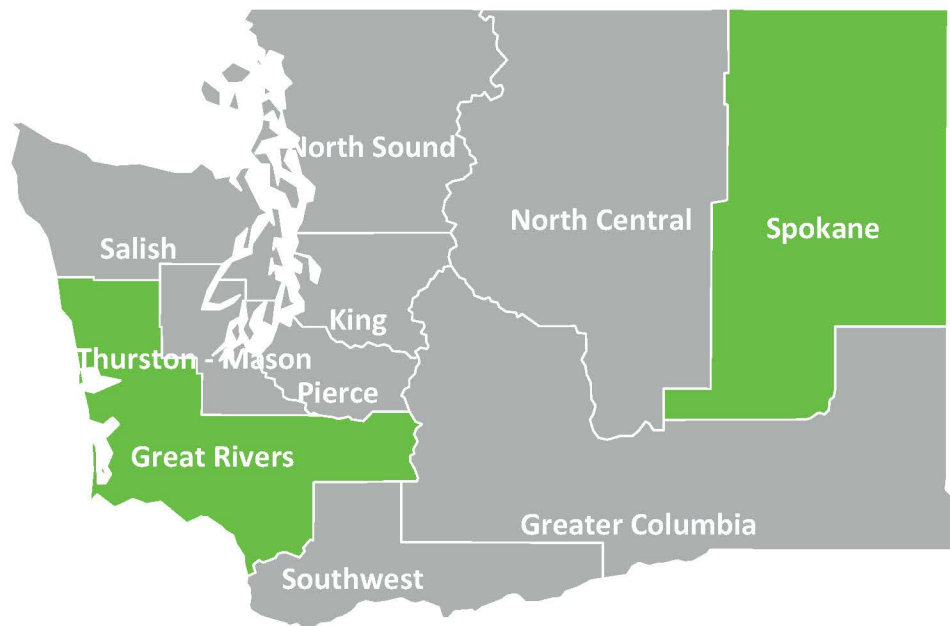

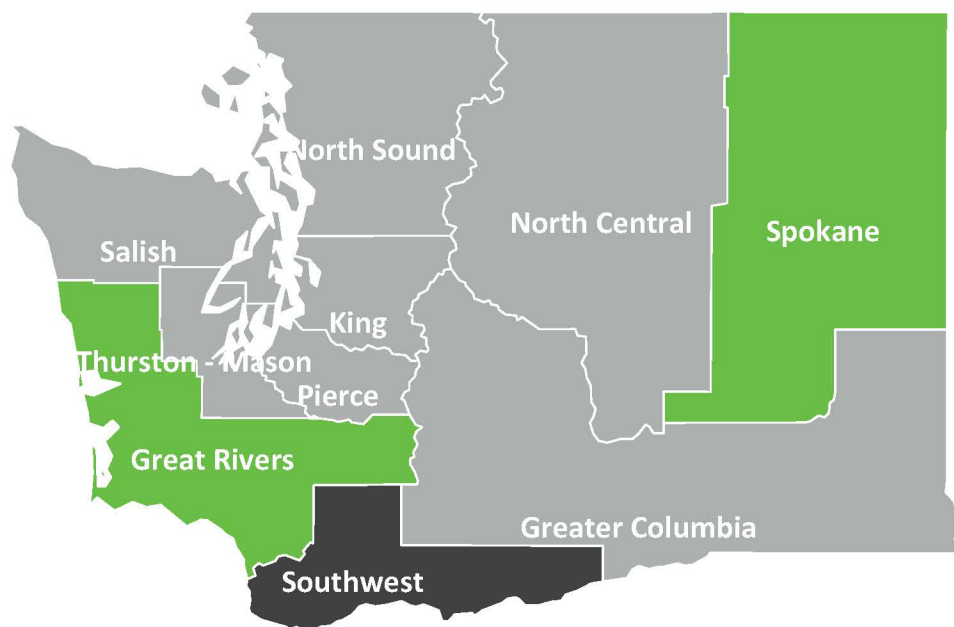

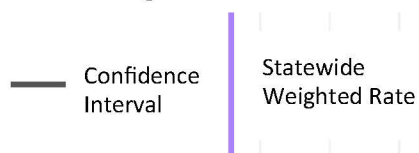

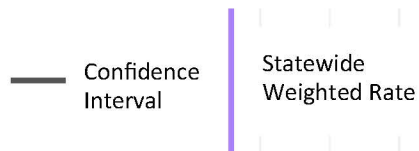

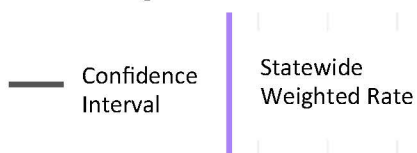

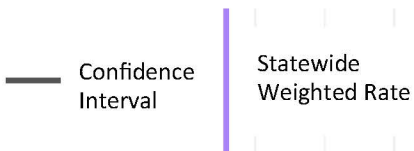

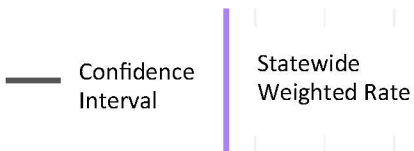

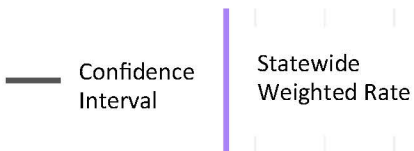

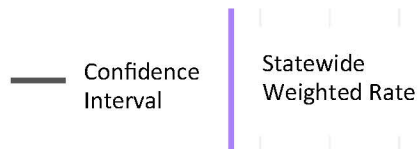

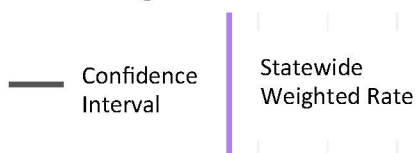

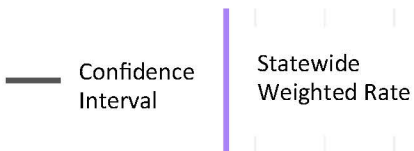

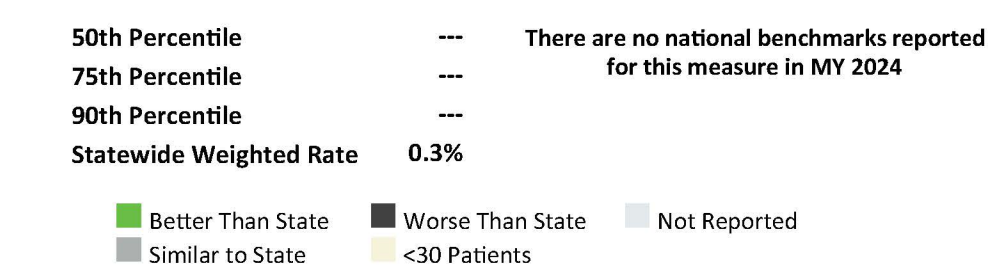

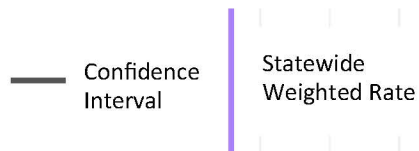
